- 4. Galloping Out Report –There are currently 22 horses in the program, with one more horse waiting to be accepted into the program. Adoptions are ramping up as the year ends. For its sixth consecutive year, Thunder Cares, the charitable arm of Norman Mechanical, boosted Galloping Out, the ITHA's re-homing program, with a \$10,000 contribution.
